Lesson No.10

Exercise of Movement: Standing Fatha, Kasrah, Dhuma and Madoleen or Tanween

Instructions:

If there is Hamzah (ء) after Maddah, maddah will be any of the four kinds. 1) if Hamzah is in the same word Maddah will be called maddah Mutasil. (جَاءَ) 2) If Hamzah is in the beginning of the next word, Maddah will be called Madd-e-Munfasil. (إِنَّا نَتَرَلْنَا) 3) if there is Sakoon (Silent) after a Maddah or Leen Letters the word will be prolonged like Madd and is called Madd-e-Lazim. (آلَنَ) 4) If Sakoon is due to waqaf (Stop) madd is called Madd-e-Arzi (Casual). (جُوعَ). All these Madd's are prolonged from three to five seconds.
